

## **How To Make**

## **BOTTLE BRICKS!**

**Step 1** - Collect #2 plastic bottles:

One liter or

20 oz Energy Drink (wide top)

Not water bottles; they're too lightweight.

Step 2 - Collect clean, dry,

## non-biodegradable items that cannot be recycled. No paper!

- Mesh bags
- Bag twisties
- Bread tags
- Yogurt tops
- Dead batteries
- Aluminum foil

- Sticky labels
- Candy wrappers
- Snack bags
- Thermal receipts
- Plastic wine plugs
- Drink packets

- Dead credit cards
- Straws & swizzlers
- Wax candle stubs
- Dried pens/markers

(Cutting items into small

pieces is helpful)

## Step 3 - Line the bottle bottom with

something form-fitting such as a small plastic bag. Fill the bottles, compressing as you go. It's handy to have a bottle out on your counter. 1 liter bottles should weigh 250+ gms & 20 oz bricks, ~180 gms.
